Low risk – a minor injury e.g. scratch or bruise

Medium risk – significant loss/damage or injury such as broken bones (requires hospital trip)

High risk – extensive loss, multiple injuries or death

Feeding the fire	Adults/ children	Burns, scolds, scratches, clothes catching fire	High	Dry stick/twigs/wood to be accessible (no leaving the fire zone) Feed the fire at a safe distance (demonstration from FSL). FSL to keep the fire under control Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Long hair/ clothing	Adults/ children	Clothing/hair catching alight, burns, serious injury, death	High	FSL will ensure hair is tied back and assist if necessary FSL will ensure any dangling from clothing is tucked away or removed (scarfs, cords) FSL will continually check learners are a safe distance from the fire. No synthetic gloves to be worn Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Fire kit/blanket/gloves Bucket of water and towel	Medium	Cooking/ boiling water and using cooking utensils will develop the learner's skills and give them a great sense of achievement.
Smoke	Adults/ children	Smoke inhalation, irritation of the airways	High	Position the fire away from building and trees Wind direction constantly assessed Children to safely move away from smoke Use dry suitable wood Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Bucket of water and towel	Medium	Learners will be aware of their surroundings giving them the
Heat from fire	Adults/ children	Redding to the skin, clothes catching fire	Medium	FSL continually checking the children are distanced from fire Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Bucket of water and towel	Low	responsibility of maintaining and preserving their Forest School
Boiling water/ cooking food	Adults/ Children	Burns, scolding, eye injuries	High	Demonstration and safe working distance 1.5m Appropriate PPE, clothing and closed toe footwear Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Bucket of water and towel Appropriate clean and safe cooking utensils Children to follow behaviour policy and fire circle rules	Medium	Managing their own risks and make safer choices for
Fire spreading out of control	Adults/ Children/ local environment	Major damage to the local environment, Scalds, burns, loss of life	High	FSL to continuously supervise the fire and never leave the fire zone Weather checked before lighting a fire Fire service contacted before fire is started. Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit. Bucket of water and towel	Medium	themselves and others.

Falls onto the fire	Adults/ Children	Scalds, burns, loss of life	High	FSL to talk, demonstrate (if necessary) and supervise the behaviour around the fire zone Learners to follow behaviour policy and fire circle rules Qualified First aider and fully stocked first aid kit.
